Direct Applicants

Direct Applicants are applicants to be selected on the strength of their WASSCE/SSSCE. They usually do not write the University's Entrance Examinations except for programmes whose entry requirements so demand.

Mature Applicants

- Mature Applicants are those required to pass the University's entrance examination; comprising a Subject Area Test (SAT) and a General Aptitude Test (GAT), conducted by AAMUSTED before selection.
- Applicants must be 25 years old or above by 1st September of the year of application. These applicants may have WASSCE/SSSCE/GCE or academic/professional/trade certificates, but cannot obtain direct admission, because they do not have the required passes.
- Applicants must show proof of age with a birth certificate or any legitimate documentary proof (passport, driver's license, voter ID, Ghana Card, that is not less than 5 years old at the time of application.

Post-Diploma Applicants

Post-Diploma Applicants are applicants who have a Higher National Diploma or equivalent Tertiary Diploma Certificates. They usually seek admission to pursue degrees in their previous areas of study.

Applicants must have grades A1-C6/A-D, respectively in three (3) core subjects: (English Language, Integrated Science, and Core Mathematics) and three (3) Electives from the following subjects: Automotive Mechanics, Elective Mathematics, Physics, Engineering Science, Chemistry, Technical Drawing, Biology, Applied Electricity, Electronics, Metalwork, Welding, Information Technology, Economics and Geography.

CTVET or NABPTEX Certificate Holders

Applicants must have six (6) passes; comprising three (3) core subjects: (English Language, Integrated Science, and Core Mathematics) and three (3) elective subjects in the relevant area of study from the Technical Exams Unit (TEU) of Ghana Education Service (GES).

GCE Advanced Level Certificate Holders

Applicants must have grade D or better in three Science subjects. They must also have credit passes (grade 6) in five (5) GCE 'O' Level subjects, including English Language and Mathematics.

- *For applicants to B.Sc. Natural Resources Management and B.Sc. Agriculture Engineering, Technology and Innovation Education, any three of the above elective subjects can suffice. Also, credit passes in Geography, Economics, and Government are acceptable for Natural Resources but not Agriculture Engineering.*
- *Regarding B.Sc. Agribusiness Management and Entrepreneurship Education, credit passes in all the business subjects are acceptable.*

Elective Mathematics, Geography, Economics, Food and Nutrition, General Knowledge in Art, Literature, French, Twi, etc.

SSSCE Certificate Holders

Applicants must have Six (6) credit passes; (A-D) in three (3) core subjects: (English Language, Mathematics, and Integrated Science) and at least a credit in Chemistry and any two (2) of the following electives:

- Physics
- Biology
- General Agriculture
- Animal Husbandry

B.Sc. Public Health

General Entry Requirements

- **Science Students**

For holders of WASSCE, SSSCE, and School Certificate/GCE Certificate, candidates should have Core Mathematics, English Language, and Integrated Science (Grades A1-C6). Additionally, they should have three electives: Chemistry, Physics, Biology, or Elective Mathematics.

- **International Science Students**

The required subjects are English Language, Mathematics, Biology/General Agriculture, Physics, and Chemistry plus one Arts subject and Further Mathematics.

- **Non-Science Students**

For certificate holders of WASSCE, SSSCE, and School Certificate/GCE Certificate, candidates should have passed (Grades A1-C6) in three core subjects: Integrated Science, English Language, Core Mathematics, and Social Studies. Additionally, they should have obtained (Grades A1-C6) in three of the following elective subjects: Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Elective Mathematics, Food and Nutrition, General Knowledge in Art, Economics, Animal Husbandry, Geography, Government, History, Literature in English, General Agriculture, Information Communication Technology and Management in Living.

- **Top-Up Students (Diploma and Professional Certificate Holders)**

Candidates with Diplomas awarded by recognised institutions will gain entry into level 300. Such candidates must have obtained a Diploma from a Ministry of Health

Training Institution or an Institution whose Diplomas are recognised by GTEC or a University. Professional Certificate Holders in SRN, Public Health Nursing (PHN), and other health-related programmes are also eligible. They must have a final grade point average (FGPA) of 2.50 or better in the Diploma Programme. However, certificate holders will gain entry into level 200.

*All Public Health Applicants **must** pass a selection interview.*

SSSCE Certificate Holders

Applicants with SSSCE should have “D” or better in English Language, Mathematic and Integrated Science or Social Studies, and any three elective subjects, (A-D). Total aggregate should not be more than 24.

CTVET or NABPTEX Certificate Holders

Applicants must have three (3) passes; comprising two (2) core subjects: including English Language and Core Mathematics, and two (2) elective subjects from the Technical Exams Unit (TEU) of Ghana Education Service (GES) or any two (2) elective subjects in the relevant area of study.
